June Craft Materials List

Hello! Below is a list of the projects we'll be doing this June in our Animal Adventure and Elementary Zoom programs. We tried to make this list as complete and accurate and inexpensive as possible.

We have one **CRAFT DAY** scheduled for each week. However, we also have a **MASHUP DAY** which might include a bonus craft, recipe, or special guest. If you don't see a mashup day listed, it means we'll be doing something on that day that doesn't require materials.

We Try to Make Everything as Cheap as Possible!

We realize that many parents are on a tight budget. We work very hard to keep the material costs low. Many of the activities use recycled materials and/or things around the house. The other materials are general craft

supplies that can be purchased at the dollar store. Below is a general list of materials used in our projects. It's followed by a week by week breakdown of the crafts and materials.

Household materials needed for June crafts:

Paper towels, scissors, pencil, craft glue, gluestick or scotch tape, washable markers, thumbtack or nail to poke holes, cotton swab or small piece of sponge for painting, water, coat hanger & string (optional for mobile), colored pencils (optional), additional recycled file folders or cardstock (optional to expand book), something to protect your work surface and shirts from markers, paint, and water

Grocery materials needed for June snack craft in Week 3:

1 Slice of Bread (white, wheat, or whatever), 1 Tablespoon of Spread: Peanut Butter OR Cream Cheese OR Jam OR Guacamole, Decorations: Banana Slices, Grape Halves, Blueberries, Raisins, Almonds: (Decorations can be mixed, matched, and substituted with other ingredients)

Week #1 Farm Friends

CRAFT DAY PROJECT: Cow Over the Moon Paper Plate Spinner

Materials:

In the Kit:

- 2 Paper Plates
- 1 Piece of White Cardstock
- 1 Paper Fastener
- Black and White Paint
- larger Piece of Kitchen Sponge (for sponging paint)

You provide:

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Gluestick or Scotch Tape
- Black Marker or Black Crayon



MASHUP DAY PROJECT: Clucking Chicken Cups

Materials:

In the Kit:

- Red Solo Drinking Cup
- 2 Feet of Yarn or String
- 1 Small Piece of Orange Craft Foam for the beak
- 2 large Googly Eyes
- 1-3 Feathers
- Smaller Piece of clean Kitchen Sponge

You provide:

- Thumbtack or nail (with adult supervision)
- Gluestick or Scotch Tape
- Water to wet sponge



Week #2: Fish Tails

CRAFT DAY PROJECT: “Printed” Ocean Scenes

In the Kit:

- 1 Styrofoam plate
- 1 piece of White Copy Paper

You provide:

- Clean Damp Sponge, Paper Towel, or spray bottle with water
- 1 Dull Pencil
- Washable Markers



MASHUP DAY PROJECT: Coffee Filter Fish

Cover your work surface! The markers will bleed through the filters!

In the Kit:

Jellyfish:

- 1 whole coffee filter
- 2 large 20mm googly eyes
- 6 pieces of curling ribbon (1 ½ ft.)

Fish

- 2 halves of a Basket-style Coffee Filter
- 2 Rubber Bands (1 per fish)
- 4 sticker eyes from strip (1-2 per fish)

You provide:

- 1 Paper Towel (a wad of toilet paper or a napkin will also work)
- Washable Markers
- Gluestick or Scotch Tape (for jellyfish)
- Coat hanger (optional for mobile)
- String or yarn (optional if making mobile)



Week #3 Pet Pals

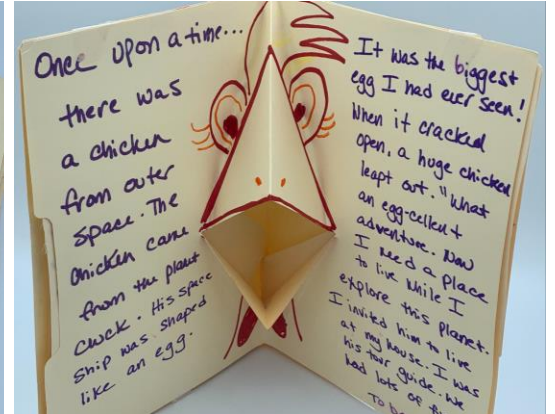
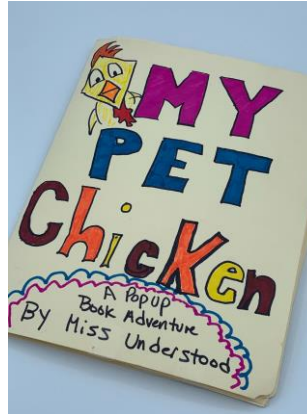
CRAFT DAY: Pet Pop-Up Book

In the Kit:

- 2 Manilla File Folders
- 2 sticker eyes from strip

You provide:

- Scissors
- Markers or Crayons or Colored Pencils
- Gluestick or Scotch Tape



MASHUP DAY RECIPE: Pet Pal Open Face Sandwiches

You provide:

- 1 Slice of Bread (white, wheat, or whatever)
- 1 Tablespoon of Spread: Peanut Butter OR Cream Cheese OR Jam OR Guacamole
- Decorations: Banana Slices, Grape Halves, Blueberries, Raisins, Almonds.

(Decorations can be mixed, matched, and substituted with other ingredients.)



Week # 4 Celebrity Critters

CRAFT DAY PROJECT: Celebrity Paw Prints

In the Kit:

- 1 Piece of Black Construction Paper
- 1 Piece of Yellow Construction Paper
- 1 white paint pot
- 1 larger Piece of Craft Foam or a Styrofoam plate
- Animal Paw Print Template
- Star Template

You provide:

- Old Plastic Tub Cover (from yogurt, sour cream, Tupperware, etc.)
- Craft Glue
- Marker (any dark color)
- Cotton swab
- Glitter Glue (optional)
