How to Make the Toy Poodle

Model No. 1 (page 8)

This is the most basic model.

If you can learn this, it'll be easy to make the other dogs!



MATERIALS

Model No. 1 (page 8)

- One 6mm beige pipe cleaner, approx. 40" (1m)
- Two 3mm toy eyes
- One 4.5mm bear nose

How to Make the Other Models (page 8)

• Model No. 2

Make the same way as No. 1, but use gray pipe cleaner.

• Model No. 3

Make the same way as No. 1, but use red brown pipe cleaner.

• Model No. 4

Make the same way as No. 1, but use medium brown pipe cleaner.

• Model No. 5

Make the same way as No. 1., but glue a %" (1cm) length of copper pipe cleaner to the head to make a pointy hairstyle.


• Model No. 6

Make the same way as No. 1, using ivory pipe cleaner. Make the eyes using black pipe cleaner (see p. 75). Make the mouth with a piece of thick black thread (see p. 74).

• Model No. 7


Make the same way as No. 1., using black pipe cleaner, and paint on eye whites (see p. 79).

All pipe cleaners used should be 40" (1m) long unless otherwise noted.




Bend the tip of the beige pipe cleaner ¼" (0.5cm), then bend it at 1" (2.5cm).

Using the bent part as the core, wrap the pipe cleaner around the core three times from the top down. Leave about %" (1cm) at the bottom.



Bend the pipe cleaner as shown, then twist twice at the base of the ears. Wrap the pipe cleaner around from the back and push it through to the front. Pull until there is no slack.





Turn the head back around to the front. Now push the ears down. The face is complete.

Turn the head around to the back side and wrap the pipe cleaner around the right ear, then the left ear, making a figure eight. Insert the pipe cleaner under the diagonal portion (marked with a \star), and pull down.



Bend the pipe cleaner coming out of the back of the head as shown. Twist the %" (1.5cm) section to make the tail.




Bring the pipe cleaner forward to the neck and wrap it tightly around the neck twice. Include the head core piece when wrapping by bending it back along the torso.




MAKE THE LEGS


Bend the pipe cleaner to make a 1¼" (3cm) leg, pass it through the torso, and bring it out the other side.



Make a second leg on the other side, then twist both front legs in a spiral motion all the way down.




Bring the pipe cleaner along the torso to the tail, make a 11/4" (3cm) leg, and pass the pipe cleaner through the torso to the other side.



Make another leg on the other side, then twist both back legs. This completes the legs.



How to Make the Pug

Model No. 33 (page 20)

The key to this dog is the forehead wrinkles.

You can create an expressive face by making the base in 6mm pipe cleaner, then using 3mm pipe cleaner for the wrinkles.

MATERIALS

Model No. 33 (page 20)

- One 6mm beige pipe cleaner, approx. 40" (1m)
- One 6mm black pipe cleaner, approx. 12" (30cm)
- Two 3.5mm toy eyes
- One 4.5mm bear nose



Make the same way as No. 34, adding 3mm black pipe cleaner wrinkles around the eyes and on the head. Use black toy eyes and paint on eye whites (see p. 79).



 Cut a 4" (10cm) section of black pipe cleaner, bend the first third at a 90 degree angle, then arrange the short end (marked with a ★) to bend towards the corner. This will be the mouth.

*A brown pipe cleaner is used here instead of black to make it easier to see.

Bend the tip of the beige pipe cleaner ¼" (0.5cm), then bend it at 1" (2.5cm). Using the bent part as the core, wrap the pipe cleaner around the core three times from the top down. Leave about ¾" (1cm) at the bottom.








Hold the ★ portion while inserting

the black mouth made in step 1.

Turn the head around and use the remaining black pipe cleaner to make the ears. Again, hold the ★ portion while adjusting the shape.





Turn the head back around to the front, and wrap the beige pipe cleaner around the right ear, then the left ear, making a figure eight. This is how the forehead wrinkles are formed.



Bend the pipe cleaner coming out of the back of the head as shown. Twist the 3/8" (1 cm) section to make the tail, bring the pipe cleaner forward to the neck, and wrap tightly twice. Include the core piece when wrapping as shown.







Pass the pipe cleaner over the tail and between the legs and wrap it tightly around the torso towards the neck. Once you reach the neck, wrap it more loosely once around the neck.



Next, wrap it loosely around the torso towards the tail, to create a fluffy look.



Once the pipe cleaner reaches the tail, pass it over the tail and down through the legs. If there is any pipe cleaner left over, leave a little extra for step 15 and cut off the rest.





Bend the tip of the pipe cleaner slightly, apply a drop of glue to the tip, and insert it into the torso. Finally, bend the tail forward slightly.






Put some glue on the face where the eyes and nose will go. Insert the nose in the middle of the mouth made from black pipe cleaner, and insert the eyes as shown. Bend the legs slightly, adjust the body shape, and you're done!



Use a small brush and water-based enamel or acrylic paint to draw on eye whites (see p. 79).

How to Make the **Boston Terrier**

Model No.19 (page 15)

The contrasting mouth, neck, and feet and the slightly droopy mouth make this dog design a true Boston Terrier.

MATERIALS

Model No. 19 (page 15)

- · One 6mm white pipe cleaner, approx. 40" (1m)
- · One 6mm black pipe cleaner, approx. 12" (30cm)
- Two 4mm toy eyes
- · One 4.5mm bear nose

How to Make the Other Models (page 15)


• Model No. 18

Make the same way as No. 19, and draw eye whites around the outside of black toy eyes with water-based enamel (see p. 79). --


• Model No. 20

Make the same way as No. 18, take some of the leftover pipe cleaner from step 13, and attach it to the belly.

All pipe cleaners used should be 40" (1m) long unless otherwise noted.









Bend the tip of the black pipe cleaner ¼" (0.5cm), then bend it at 1" (2.5cm). Using the bent part as the core, wrap the pipe cleaner around the core three and a half times from the top down. Leave about 3/8" (1 cm) at the bottom.

*A gray-brown pipe cleaner is used here instead of black to make it easier to see.



Bend the pipe cleaner as shown, then twist twice at the base of the ears.



Bring the pipe cleaner around from the back to the front, and wrap it around the right ear, then the left ear, making a figure eight.




Turn the head around, pass the pipe cleaner under the diagonal portion (marked with a ★), and pull it down.



Insert the white. pipe cleaner where the * is shown, and twist the black pipe cleaner around it to hold it in place. Cut them so they are the same length as the head core.









Bring the white pipe cleaner around from the back to the front and down the center of the face. Bend it as shown to make the lower half of the face.




Wrap it around twice, then insert it into the center and pull it out the back of the head. Bend down the corners and adjust the shape. This will be the mouth.



Bend the pipe cleaner coming out of the back of the head as shown. Fold back the the twisted piece from step 5. Twist the ¾" (1cm) section to make the tail, bring the pipe cleaner forward to the neck, and wrap tightly twice. Include the core piece when wrapping as shown.




Bend the pipe cleaner to make a 1¼" (3cm) leg, pass it through the torso, and make a second leg on the other side. Twist both front legs.




Bring the pipe cleaner along the torso to the tail, make a 1¼" (3cm) back leg, and pass the pipe cleaner through the torso to the other side.



Make another leg on the other side, then twist both legs. The legs are complete.



Pass the pipe cleaner over the tail and between the legs and wrap it tightly around the torso towards the neck.





Insert a black pipe cleaner with glue on the tip into the bottom of the belly and wind it around the entire body towards the tail, hiding the white. Wrap loosely to create a fluffy look.





Fig. 1: Once you reach the tail end, pass the pipe cleaner between the legs and wind it up around the tail, covering the entire tail. Fig. 2: Bring it down through the back legs again and cut it with a little room to spare at the end. Bend the tip, add a dab of glue, and insert it into the torso.



Put glue on the posts of the eyes and nose. Insert the nose into the center of the mouth that was made at steps 6–7, and insert the eyes above the mouth.



Bend the tips of the legs a bit, adjust the body shape, and your terrier is complete.
